

**Student Rights & Responsibilities:
Drug Testing for Students**

FNF (Regulation)

**Purpose of the Drug
Testing Program**

Mullin ISD has a vital interest in maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all of its students. Being under the influence of drugs and alcohol poses a serious health and safety risk to both the user and all those associated with the user. Likewise, maintaining a drug free school is crucial in preserving a positive learning environment. To fulfill this purpose, the District will implement student drug testing on a limited basis where there is reasonable cause to believe doing so will result in evidence of a violation of a school policy or rule.

Procedures

Testing will be coordinated by the District and at the District's expense. Test results must be provided to the District, and appropriate disciplinary consequences will be assessed in accordance with the Mullin ISD Student Code of Conduct. Test results will be kept confidential from school personnel other than those with a legitimate, educational need to be aware of such results.

Appeals

A student or parent wishing to appeal the District's decision to require drug testing, or to appeal the disciplinary consequences which may result, may follow Policy FNG (Local).
